## **Summer Reading Challenge 2025 and Staffordshire Libraries**

### **FAQs for schools and families**

➤ **When does the Summer Reading Challenge start /end?**

Start Date: Saturday 5 July 2025

End Date: Monday 15 September 2025

➤ **What age do children have to be to take part?**

Children aged under 4 can complete the Mini Challenge

Children aged 4 and over can complete the Main Challenge

There is no bottom or top age-limit for the Challenge.

➤ **How does my child take part?**

Children need to visit a Staffordshire Library with a parent / carer who can agree to them taking part in the Challenge.

They will need to have a library card in their name.

Parents / carers complete a quick registration card for the Challenge (we can help with this if needed).

Ideally, we ask that children borrow six books during the Challenge and visit the library three times to do this, but we are happy for children to decide the number of books for themselves and visit as many times as they need to.

Children will receive a sticker sheet when they register for the Challenge. There are three sets of stickers to collect.

Once all stickers have been collected, the child will be given a medal and a certificate.

Taking part in the Challenge is completely free.

➤ **What type of books does my child have to read?**

All types of books are eligible e.g. board books, picture books, fiction and non fiction, audio books, comics / graphic novels.

Your child can borrow physical books from the library or they can download books from our e-library (this include e-audio books and e-comics as well as e-books)

The only condition is that children must borrow the books from a Staffordshire Library; they cannot just read books they already have at home.

➤ **What if a child doesn't have a library card?**

Library cards are free.

Parents / carers can get one for their child from any Staffordshire Library or they can join their child online here

If the child has had a library card before and it has been lost, we can give them a replacement one.

➤ **What if my child has unreturned books on their library card and we've not lost or can't find them?**

Don't worry! Please come and tell us about this and we will clear the unreturned books from your child's library card.

We want your family to use the library, not put barriers in the way.

➤ **I can't take my child to the library. Can they still do the Challenge?**

If you want your child to have the stickers and medal / certificate, you will need to bring them to the library to register and to collect their rewards.

You could borrow books for them through our e-library if you cannot visit the library to choose physical books.

A 'whole of the UK' online Summer Reading Challenge is also available here <https://summerreadingchallenge.org.uk/>

Children do not need to visit the library to take part. They will receive virtual rewards rather than the physical stickers / medal / certificate.

➤ **Are there any activities at the library during the summer holidays?**

Yes! Burton and Uttoxeter libraries will run a programme of free or low-cost activity for families to enjoy. Pick up a leaflet from the library or check out our Instagram @burtonlibrary @uttoxeterlibrary for more information.

## Our Offer

Our **breakfast club** runs from 8:00am to 8.40am, Monday to Friday.

The club is fully supervised in the school hall by our staff, providing a safe and fun start to the day. *Please note, supplementary staff from within the school may also be in attendance in addition to our permanent staff to meet the needs of our school.*

Parents are not permitted to enter the provision when in operation due to safeguarding regulations. From 8:00am, parents must access the school via the playground entrance only and take their child into school via the Main School Office. A member of staff will greet you before taking your child into the hall for registration.

Our club includes a range of activities such as games, reading, and physical activities to name but a few. If any child has an accident whilst in our care, as parents, you will be informed in accordance with our procedures.

There is a choice of breakfast cereals, toast and preserves, and also a selection of fruit every day. Apple juice, milk and water are also available.

## Pricing

**£4.00 per session**

Please note that sessions **MUST** be booked on a weekly basis, by 12noon the Friday before you wish to book. This is to ensure correct supervision ratios are applied. Children cannot turn up on the day without a session being booked in advance. Places are limited to 35 children per day. Parents **MUST** be aware that your child will not be permitted into Breakfast Club if a place has not been previously booked.

**ALL PAYMENTS TO BE MADE VIA MCAS**

**(If you are unable to book a place for your child, this means the provision is full for the forthcoming week)**

We are not yet set up for Childcare Vouchers, so these will not apply initially. These will be an accepted payment method in the future, and we will advise when this has been implemented.

## Our Offer

Our **after-school club** runs from 3:30pm until 6:00pm, Monday to Friday.

The club is fully supervised in the school hall and outside by our staff, providing a safe and fun end to the day.

Parents are not permitted to enter the provision when in operation due to safeguarding regulations. Parents must notify staff that their child is being collected by accessing the door at the side of the staffroom door. A member of staff will greet you before handing your child to you with their belongings. There will be a doorbell on this door. Club staff will also have a 'Club phone' for emergencies only.

Those children who are attending any of our extra-curricular clubs can be taken to their chosen clubs or go independently if they are mature enough

and if they are attending the after-school club. We will ensure they are collected and are registered to our care after their club finishes.

During Mosley Night Owls, the children are free to choose from a selection of both planned and unplanned activities which enhance the provision. Resources are readily available, which include arts and crafts, colouring and drawing, board games, construction, role play, physical play and quiet areas for reading and homework etc. There are also themed nights based on the celebrations of other cultures and traditions, where the children can all get creative.

A light snack will be made available (prepared by Mellors Catering). The snacks will vary from a selection of sandwiches and wraps. A cake and a selection fruit will also be available, along with fresh water. If your child prefers, they may bring their own snack. Please advise of any dietary requirements.

## Pricing

**3:30pm-4:30pm £6.00 per session**

**3:30pm-6:00pm £15.00 per session**

Please note that sessions **MUST** be booked on a weekly basis, by 12noon the Friday before you wish to book. This is to ensure correct supervision ratios are applied. Children cannot turn up on the day without a session being booked in advance. Places are limited to 35 children per day, and due to Health & Safety legislation, we cannot admit over that ratio. Parents **MUST** be aware that your child will not be permitted into the after-school club if a place has not been previously booked, and parents will be contacted to collect their child from school.

An additional £5.00 surcharge will be applied for parents collecting late after 6:00pm, when the after-school officially closes.

**ALL PAYMENTS TO BE MADE VIA MCAS**  
**(2 booking options will be available)**

We are not yet set up for Childcare Vouchers, so these will not apply initially. These will be an accepted payment method in the future, and we will advise when this has been implemented.
