
MATHS SUBJECT EXCELLENCE PROJECTS

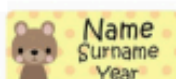
