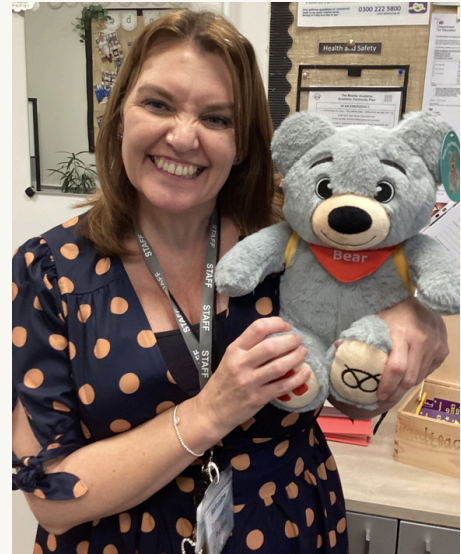


MATHS SUBJECT EXCELLENCE PROJECTS
