Christmas Party Day Friday 19th- come in Christmas party clothes - and keep your fingers crossed for a special visitor who may be passing at some point in the day!

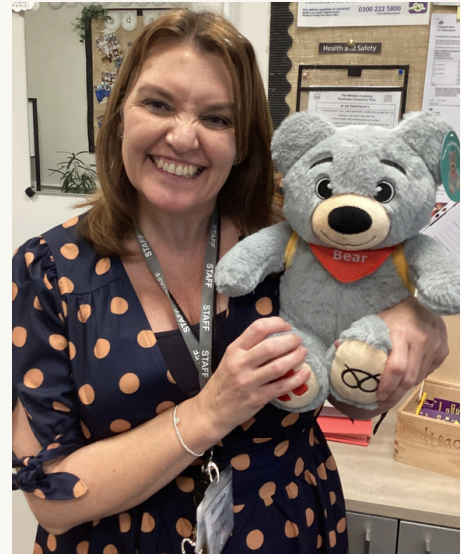
