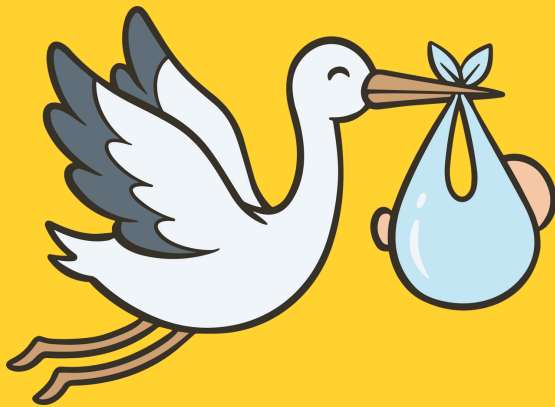

KS1 and EYFS 3.30 until 4.30pm and KS2 4.40 until 5.50pm

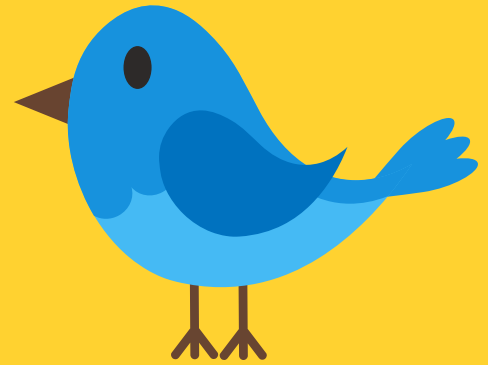
