Back to school on Monday 1st June, enjoy the break!

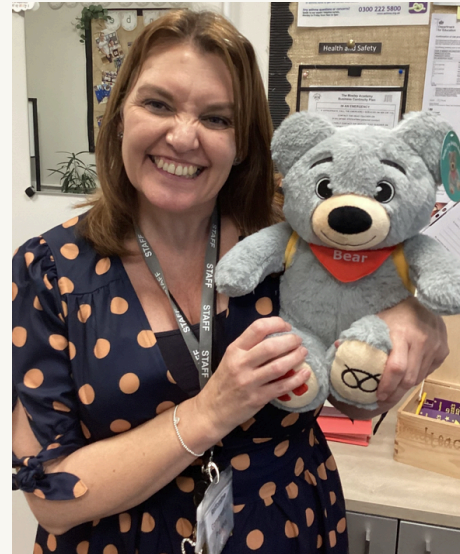
