The school will be closed to all pupils on Friday 3rd July for a MAT wide training day.

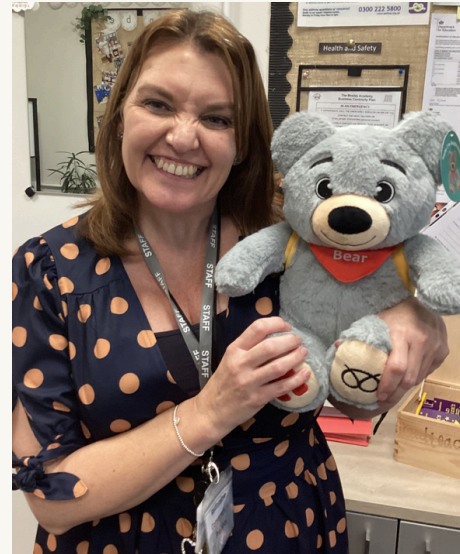
