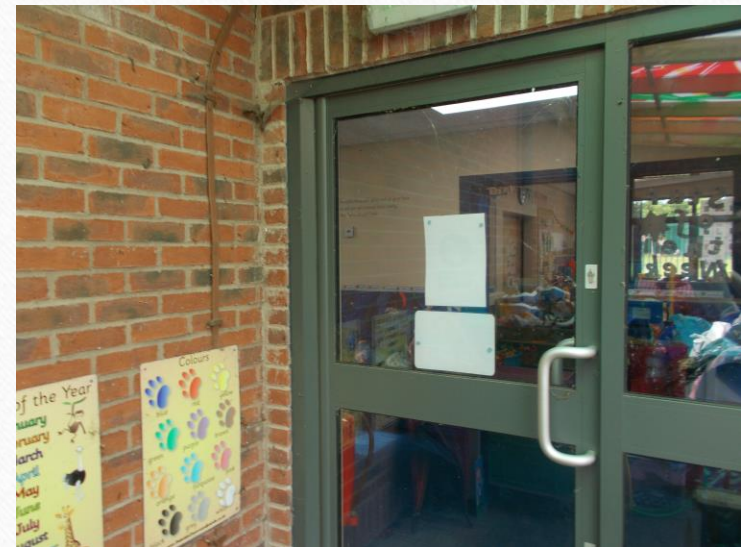
This is Mrs

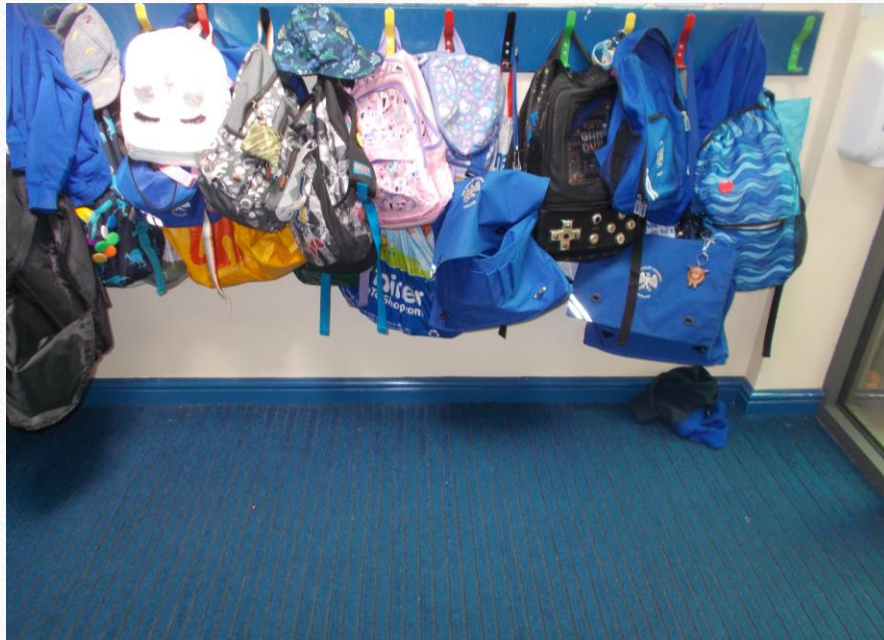
When you come to school in the morning
