Climbing Frame Update

As many of you may be aware, last summer we were fundraising to replace the main climbing frame in the school playground. This has needed replacing for a while, and we invested considerable time and effort into researching and choosing a suitable replacement with well established playground specialists. The PTA then contributed some funds towards the deposit for this. Over the past six months, we have unfortunately been pursuing the company as they have failed to provide the equipment after going into administration. This is ongoing, working with the support of the Trust, other schools and external organisations. We are obviously very upset by this, and have worked tirelessly to try and get the funding back. The climbing frame and rubber flooring was repaired over the summer using PTA funds to make the current equipment suitable for continued use while we continue to try and resolve the situation.
