We have also met with an external sports coaching company this week to look at reinstating our holiday clubs to support child care over the holidays. We will be sending out a brief online form next week from the provider to gather your requirements.

Curriculum Newsletters

In response to parent feedback, we have been looking at how we can improve the information we provide to you on child's learning and how to support your child at home. Attendance

As we begin the new school year, we would like to reiterate the school and JTMAT expectations around school attendance and punctuality. The school doors are open from 8.40am - arrival after 8.55am will be recorded as a late arrival, and arrival after 9.10am when registers close is recorded as an unauthorised absence. If you need to request a leave of absence, forms are available from the office, however these will only be authorised in very exceptional circumstances. The government have recently introduced stricter penalties for unauthorised absences, and we ask that you please ensure your child is in school unless their absence is absolutely unavoidable.
