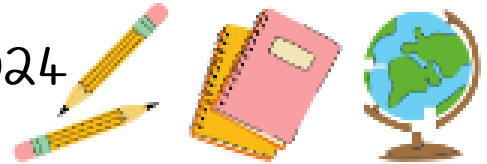


DONALDSON CLASS NEWS

We have created some pictures outside during our outdoor learning of our families with natural resources.

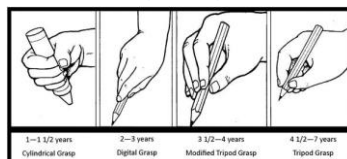
We have been talking about sharing in PSHE this week.
