However, we will soon be switching over to use a new app called MyChildAtSchool which links directly to Bromcom, our in school data management system. As well as streamlining our processes and saving a significant amount in the school budget, we are hoping that this change will prove beneficial in providing you with easy to use and accessible communications, payments and data management facilities. Over the next few weeks we will be sending out information to gradually move all families over to Bromcom with the transition being completed by the end of term, so please keep an eye out for messages regarding this!
