Letter from Mrs Rowe

Dear Parents,

At our school, we are highly committed to fostering a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all pupils and staff. A key part of this is helping children take responsibility for their actions and understand the importance of making positive choices. Respect and Responsibility are two of our very important Mosley 4 R's. As you will all be aware, we review our behaviour procedure at least annually and this is available to all parents and the community via the school website. Our behaviour procedure is called a Relational and Restorative Behaviour Procedure: [download.asp](#)

We have the highest of expectations of pupils conduct both in and out of school; in lesson times and at play. The very high majority of our pupils meet these expectations every single day. However, when rules are not followed, our behaviour procedures and practices are in place to guide pupils towards reflection, repair and growth. This does not mean that we do not issue clear sanctions and consequences. We do. What we certainly do not do, is publicise these consequences to other children and our community.

We will share with you when we have concerns about your child's behaviour in order to keep you informed. We kindly ask for your support in reinforcing the school's expectations and values at home too, supporting the school behaviour procedures by encouraging your child to accept the consequences of their actions and learn from them. All staff are fully committed to doing their very best for all the children. They go above and beyond, day in and day out to enable all children to succeed both academically and socially. We want all children to thrive and above all, we care so much about the children.

Together, we can teach our children the importance of respect for others - whether it's classmates, staff, or the broader school community. By working as partners, we help shape responsible, respectful individuals who contribute positively to our school and beyond.
